# From the massifs of the Haut Languedoc to the Mediterranean see by bike

Start your cycling trip on the Passa Païs in the Natural Park of the Haut Languedoc, continue to the magnificent UNESCO site of the Salagou Lake. Then head south to reach the Thau Lagoon and the Mediterranean Sea at Sète.



## Itinerary



This trip is the perfect ratio of diversity to time. You start your journey in Mazamet at the foot of the Black Mountain on the Tam side. You will take the 100% secure cycle track of the Passa Païs through the whole valley of the Haut Languedoc to Bédarieux. The bike path is very soft, calm, refreshing because very natural. A few pedal strokes later and you are in the sumptuous red landscapes of the Salagou lake. The next part is just as varied as you cross vineyards and olive groves before reaching Pézenas for a medieval stopover. Finish your cycling vacations in beauty by riding towards the coast. The Thau Lagoon offers you its gastronomic treasures with its white wine Picpoul de Pinet and its oysters, then finally the beautiful and big blue in Sète.



J	Mons la Trivalle - Mourèze		You will continue your trip on the Passa Païs in the direction of Poujols sur Orb, a pretty little village at the foot of the Caroux and Espinouse massifs
	Bike 43km	Altitude ±436m	little village at the foot of the Caroux and Espinouse massifs. This stage offers you an open scenery composed of chestnut trees, low shrubs of scrubland and multiple flowers. You will then pass through the famous spa town of Lamalou les bains, with its historic town center and quiet streets. Do not hesitate to visit the bell museum on your way, in Herepian, just after. You will then arrive in Bédarieux, at the gates of the Regional Natural Park of the Haut Languedoc, the end of your trip on the Passa Païs, which will have shown you all its facets. You leave Bédarieux to take the direction of the UNESCO Site of the Lake of Salagou and the Cirque of Mourèze in an ocean of greenery. The path is gentle and lets you appreciate the beauty of the wild nature of the Haut Languedoc. The more you advance on the path, the more the scenery becomes red, typical color of the land of the Salagou site.
			But before you get there, you head towards the village of Mourèze, famous for its dolomitic cirque and its white rocks.

Day 4

Mou	rèze - Pézénas	You leave Mourèze to go down towards the Mediterranean and the scenery starts to change. The olive trees make their appearance and you are surrounded by vineyards. You cross the domain of Cabrières, famous for its wines. During this stage you will cross different villages allowing you to enjoy the historical charm of the region, churches and castles built in the 13th, 16th or 18th century. At the end of the stage, you will arrive in Pézenas, emblematic city of the Hérault, known for its culinary specialties, its historical city center of the Middle Ages, its paved streets and its flea markets. City of Molière and Bobby Lapointe, Pézenas has a thousand stories to tell. On the first Sunday of May and the second Sunday of October, it is the "Grand Déballage", an antique fair that stretches over nearly a kilometer. More than 200 professional exhibitors are present all day long.
Bike <b>26.5km</b>	Altitude <u>+</u> 218m	

Pézénas - Sète It is high time to reach the big blue! On your way today: Local gastronomy and coastline. The first part of the stage allows you to enjoy the vineyards of Languedoc. Among the Bike Altitude most famous appellations of the region, cross Pinet and its emblematic dry white wine. Then head south! The Thau Lagoon can be approached from the town of Mèze. From 🖊 +200m 44km there you have the choice to take the maritime shuttle to reach Sète or to complete your itinerary by bike. For the cyclists who continue, a stop in Bouzigues is highly recommended if you are a seafood fan! The bike path around the Thau Lagoon is very pleasant and safe. You enter Sète through the historic fisherman's quarter of the Pointe courte. The city of water and light is well worth your time before heading off to new adventures. Go to its large sandy beaches to relax after your stay. Before leaving, don't forget the tielle Sétoise (delicious local specialty).
